Approved Resolution to Accept Tax-Forfeited Appraisals and Set Land Sale Date

he Board, by adoption of its Consent Agenda, approved the Resolution to accept the Tax-Forfeited Appraisals and set the on-line land sale auction date to begin April 7, 2025:

WHEREAS, Chapter 282.01 to 282.12, Minnesota Statutes 1941, as amended, provides for the sale of such lands forfeited to the State for delinquent taxes; and,

WHEREAS, The County Board will provide appraisal of such lands as provided by law, and a list of such lands will be filed with the County Auditor for the purpose of first offering such lands for sale by online auction at not less than their Estimated Market Value (EMV); and,

WHEREAS, Any properties not sold after 30 days for at least their Estimated Market Value will be offered again for sale by online auction, at not less than their Minimum Bid Value (MBV) (sum of delinquent taxes, special assessments, penalties, interest, and other costs); and,

WHEREAS, Any properties not sold after the second 30 day auction, for at least their Minimum Bid Value, will be available to purchase at the Beltrami County Administration Building for their Minimum Bid Value;

WHEREAS, Parcels required to be reviewed, have been reviewed, and approved for sale by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources,

WHEREAS, The County Board is by law designated with authority to provide for the sale of such lands; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, These parcels shall be sold through the State of Minnesota Surplus Services online auction site (MNBid.mn.gov) on any and all terms required by the auction

site, namely, all online sales must be paid in full within 10 business days of the completion of the auction. Payment must be made by money order or cashier's check made payable to "Surplus Services".

- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That all purchasers of land additionally shall pay a 3 percent surcharge of the total sale price to be paid to Minnesota Management and Budget, a state deed fee of \$25.00, a deed filing fee of \$46.00, and a state deed tax equal to the greater of \$1.65 or 0.33% of the basic sale price.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That where any lands herein offered for sale do not adjoin or are not located on a suitable legally established and maintained public highway or road, the township wherein said lands may be located, nor any other municipality shall not for a period of five years be obligated to the establishment, construction or additional maintenance of public roads or the expenditure of any public funds for the benefit of the owner or occupant of any lands herein purchased by reason of the ownership or occupancy of any of this land; provided further, that nothing herein shall be construed to create any obligation, directly or indirectly, on the part of any municipality for the expenditure of any money for the benefit of said parcel after the expiration of said five-year Responsibility for determining boundary lines of period. parcels purchased rests with the purchaser.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the right is reserved in the interest of the public to withdraw from sale, any parcel, at any time prior to its sale.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That all lands sold hereunder are sold subject to any ordinances adopted by the County Board, and all lands are sold subject to railroad and highway easements, power and pipeline easements, and subject to all flowage rights, and any other legal easements.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a notice of sale of such lands to be given by publication in the official newspaper of the County, as provided by law, that the County Auditor of Beltrami County offer such parcels of land for sale and that such sales to be to the highest bidder through an online auction beginning on April 7th, 2025

Approved Morris County Jail Bed Contract

The Board, by adoption of its Consent Agenda, approved the new two-year contract with Morrison County for jail inmate bed allocations, effective April 1, 2025-April 1, 2027.

Approved Grant Agreement & Resolution w/MN Dept of Public Safety
The Board, by adoption of its Consent Agenda, approved the Grant
Agreement and Resolution with the MN Dept of Public Safety to
assist in the replacement of portable land-mobile radios used by
patrol deputies:

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota funded an Allied Radio Matrix for Emergency Response (ARMER) grant through the Division of Emergency Communications Networks making funding available to public safety agencies; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds were awarded in a competitive application process; and

WHEREAS, the Beltrami County Sheriff's Office was awarded \$40,000.00 with a 5% local match for the replacement of aging land mobile radios; and

WHEREAS, the Beltrami County Sheriff's Office has successfully participated in grant programs from Emergency Communications Network in the past.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED Beltrami County accepts the ARMER grant and executes a grant agreement with the State of Minnesota Division of Emergency Communications Networks. Emergency Management Director/Public Information Officer Christopher Muller and Chief Deputy Jarrett Walton are appointed as

authorized representatives for Beltrami County for the ARMER grant and are hereby authorized to execute such agreements and amendments thereto, as necessary to participate in this grant.

REGULAR AGENDA

Jail Project Development Agreement

The County is required to secure all permits and state and local approvals to advance the construction of the new jail. One such approval is from the City of Bemidji for site work, utilities and landscaping. Administrator Barry discussed the review process and revisions to this final draft being recommended for approval by the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Carlson, and seconded by Commissioner Winger, to approve the Development Agreement with the City of Bemidji for the New County Jail, as submitted. Unanimously carried.

Easements with the City of Bemidji

The City of Bemidji road projects scheduled for the summer of 2025 on Hannah Ave and Middle School Dr. both will lead to permanent and/or temporary impacts to property owned by Beltrami County (PIN 80.00181.00 & 80.00168.00).

A motion was made by Commissioner Gould, and seconded by Commissioner Winger, to approve the easements on County owned property for City road projects on Hannah Ave. and Middle School Dr., as submitted. Unanimously carried.

Solid Waste Site Foreman Position

This new position would oversee the operations at the Bemidji Transfer Station. The proposed change would eliminate an SII Position and create a Site Foreman Position. This is not an additional position, but a change in a position. This position is in the budget.

A motion was made by Commissioner Carlson, and seconded by Commissioner Winger, to approve the Solid Waste Site Foreman Position and eliminate one Operations Specialist II Position. Unanimously carried.

2025 Development Fund Grant Appropriations

The Development Fund Grant application packet was sent to Commissioners for review last week. There were 10 applicants with a total request of \$119,792.00 The approved funding level is \$45,000. 1. Call to Order

Craig Gaasvig called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm

2. Introduction of New Employees

3. Identify Future Work Meeting Topics

Sanford Center Update

4. Easements with the City of Bemidji

This item was removed from the February 18th County Board Consent Agenda to allow time for the Board to gather additional information and further discuss the project with the County Engineer.

Highway Engineer, Bruce Hasbargen informed the Board that he is aware and up-to-speed with the City Engineer on this project, as well as all joint County-City projects. Mr. Hasbargen is in support of this project and the roundabouts as the best option for the intersections affected. The Board still has concerns about the impact to the ball fields parking and would like to see the City work with the League to mitigate as much disruption as possible.

5. Housing Trust Fund

Health & Human Services Director, Anne Lindseth, along with Denae Alamano from the United Way of Bemidji Area, provided an overview of accomplishments and challenges of the Housing Trust Fund.

Key accomplishments included:

- Education and strategic planning to identify priority areas for funding gathered from local agencies and housing experts
- Funding allocations processed to various programs and organizations
- Community engagement and partnerships to collaborate on future allocations

A funding balance update and future RFP plans were reviewed.

6. Beltrami County Investment Portfolio

Auditor-Treasurer, JoDee Treat discussed the County's investment portfolio and process, reviewing County principals, philosophy, arbitrage, local option sales tax and how investments are managed under State Statutory Requirements. The corrective easement redefines the easement boundary to now fully include the new forest road within the easement area.

WITNESSETH, whereas the Grantee has applied to the Grantor for the grant of an easement and right-of-way for recording a 33' x 1742.4' (1.32-acre) Right-of-Way access for ingress, egress, and utilities over certain Gerald A. Hubert and Mary Hubert owned lands, situated in the County of Beltrami.

NOW, THEREFORE, Grantor, in consideration of the sum of \$1750.00, which constitutes full payment for rights and interests herein conveyed including, timber and forest growth that will be destroyed on the easement, does hereby grant and convey unto the Grantee, forever, from and after _______, an easement and right-of-way for recording a Right-of-Way access, over and across the following described lands of Gerald A. The easement hereby created shall run with the land. This instrument and its terms and conditions shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of the parties, successors, administrators, and representatives.



- 5. Grantee shall, during construction, maintenance and operation, protect and preserve soil and scenic and aesthetic values on the rights-of-way and outside of construction limits. All of the following are conditions of this easement:
 - All slash, stumps, and root balls must be removed, buried or burned.
 - No tipped or leaning trees may remain.
- 6. Grantor shall not be liable to Grantee or any person for any injuries or damages to person or property arising from construction, operation, or maintenance of said rights-of-way.
- 7. Grantee shall establish no borrow, sand or gravel pits, stone quarry, or permanent storage areas, sites for road operations and maintenance facilities, camps, supply depots or disposal area

- within rights-of-way, except with the prior written approval of the Grantor.
- 8. Grantee may maintain the right-of-way clearing by means of chemicals upon approval in writing from the Grantor.
- 9. The use of this easement shall not be open to the public.
- 10. Grantee shall not transfer or assign this easement to any other party.

The easement and right-of-way herein conveyed may be terminated either by mutual agreement of the parties hereto, or by the Grantor upon thirty days written notice to the Grantee if Grantee fails to comply with applicable laws or the terms of this easement; otherwise to remain in effect as long as used for the purposes granted, provided, however, if the easement and right-of-way or any part thereof shall be abandoned, the rights and privileges hereby granted shall cease and terminate and the land traversed by the abandoned or unused segment shall be freed from this easement and right-of-way.
